

Dear Parents and Guardians of our Grade 6 families.

Further to the communication sent out in our Albert Lacombe BEAR Bones from Sunday May 31, I am providing a schedule and procedure for parents/guardians and students to drop off any loaned Chromebooks, textbooks and library books, and to pick up their Farewell certificates and gift sponsored by SEEALS.

On Friday June 26th, our grade 6 parents/ guardians and students will have the ability to come into the building to drop off any Chromebooks, textbooks, and library books and to pick up their child's farewell gift and Albert Lacombe Certificate. We provided a separate day for our grade 6 students and their families to come into the school to collect a farewell gift and school certificate, take any desired photos outside on the school grounds. This later date was also to ensure that any families who required district owned Chromebooks for their studies had access to technology for the grade 6 farewell ceremony. For Grade 6 families that have other children in pre-k to grade 5 registered at our school may return any Chromebooks, textbooks, and library books on June 26 in order to make one trip to the school.

In order to be flexible for families during this challenging time, we will be using the interview scheduler to have families come into the building for 15 minute intervals. A maximum of 15 families will be permitted at a time to collect their child's personal items in order to ensure we are compliant with Alberta Health Services indoor maximums for occupancy and ensure appropriate social distancing. In order to best accommodate working families, child care needs, and other considerations time intervals will be:

- Friday Morning 8:30 11:15 AM
- Friday Afternoon 12:00- 3:30 PM

In order to ensure that we are mindful of everyone's safety and well-being if you are ill or in self-isolation, please refrain from coming to the school. We are also requesting that everyone follow the protocol outlined below to ensure the wellbeing of our faculty and your immediate and extended families:

- Please enter into the school through the main entrance and exit through the sports academy entrance (midway down the school).
- To sanitize upon entry and exit of the school.
- There will be arrows on the floor to mark the 'walking flow' into the building.
- To ensure that we know who is present in the school, all families must sign in upon entry and sign out at exit. This will be completed electronically to ensure we are compliant with building occupancy limits.

- To refrain from congregating in groups and make any physical contact (e.g. handshakes) with each other inside and outside of the school building.
- Washrooms will not be accessible to visitors at this time.
- As we will be operating on a minimal faculty compliment to support this process, teachers will not be available to meet at this time.

There may be some families who wish to take photos of their children on the school grounds and are welcome to do so provided they maintain 2 meters apart from friends and other families. We will be updating our school sign with a special message for our grade 6 students for their farewell which may serve as a background.
