Dear Parents and Guardians:

This communication intends to provide parents and guardians an update regarding homeroom class placements for students for in-class programming. In the communication dated August 19, I had shared that we intended to inform parents and guardians of class placements by their child's homeroom teacher between 3:00-4:00 PM on Thursday, August 27. Regrettably, we will be delaying these announcements by one day to Friday, August 28.

To support the division online learning option for families, we, along with other district schools, had to make some adjustments to teaching assignments within our school buildings. We were not able to finalize our staffing adjustments until early Thursday evening. We are pleased to share that the online programming option for students and adjustment for teaching assignments at Albert Lacombe Catholic Elementary School has allowed us to reduce class sizes for most of our homeroom classes.

In addition to their child's homeroom placement, Friday, August 28, parents and guardians can expect further information on the following:

- Risk mitigation related to COVID within our building.
- What can parents and guardians expect for the first few days of class
- Information on pick up and drop off.

Our Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Moroziuk, will share more information about the online learning program option as part of his weekly stakeholder communication for this week.
