Dear Parents and Guardians:

As a follow up to my communication from November 26, I am reaching out to parents and guardians regarding the next transition step in planning for online learning in the new year as announced by the Premier:

On November 24, 2020, Premier Kenney announced that elementary students would return to learning online for one week following Christmas Break (Jan. 4-8) and then resume face-to-face education on January 11, 2021.

We are reaching out to parents and guardians this week to identify families who may require a Chromebook for the online learning that will occur after the Christmas break. As we have a limited number, we ask parents and guardians to consider for their child to use existing robust devices that may be available in the house, such as desktop computers, notebook computers, or Chromebooks. If you require the use of a Chromebook for that week, please reach out to your child's homeroom teacher and request **by no later than Thursday, December 10**. We will then have sufficient time to coordinate resources for students. We desire parents and guardians to sign out for these devices on Thursday, December 17 and Friday, December 18, so students are ready for learning on January 4.

Your child's homeroom teacher will reach out to you during the week of December 14-18 with further information on what schedules will look like, how to join a Google Meet, what it means to be engaged in learning, supporting online learning at home, and expectations for attendance, screen time, and assignments for that week.. As we have done with our transition to online education in the spring and school re-entry in the fall, we will continue to archive all communication on our website to facilitate access and future reference.
