### **Pre-Kindergarten Screening**

As part of the registration process for 2016-17 Pre-Kindergarten program all children must sign up for a Pre-Kindergarten screening session. Children who qualify for PUF funding are accepted into the program if they are 3 years old by March 1, 2017. All other children must be 4 years of age by March 1, 2017.

Screening is done by an occupational therapist and speech-language pathologist to help determine eligibility for a funded spot in Pre-Kindergarten. If a child is not eligible for funding through Alberta Education, there are non-funded spots available (formally "community spots") with a monthly fee.
