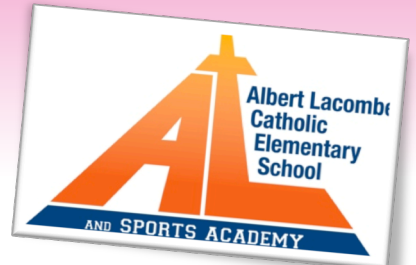
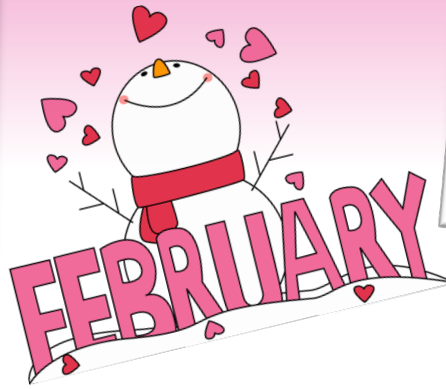

Be Seen in Pink

We plan to mark Pink Shirt Day on Wed Feb 22nd at Albert Lacombe and are inviting everyone to “Be seen in Pink”. As you may know, Pink Shirt day began with two friends in Nova Scotia:

“David Sheperd, Travis Price and their teenage friends organized a high school protest to wear pink in sympathy with a grade 9 boy who was being bullied (for wearing a pink shirt)...(They) took a stand against bullying when they protested against the harassment of a new Grade 9 student by distributing pink T-shirts to all the boys in their school.

This year, in an effort to reduce and reuse, students wear their own pink shirts from previous Pink Shirt days or any other pink item of clothes that they already have. This could be shoelaces, arm bracelets to headbands. It is not necessary to buy anything new. SEEALS will not be providing new shirts this year. If your child has outgrown their pink shirt and you would like to donate it, there will be a Pink Shirt bin set up at the entrance doors you can drop it off in. Please let your teacher know if you need a recycled pink shirt and they will be distributed as needed.
