

We have been getting ready for about two weeks and it was wonderful to finally see the students show up, taller and decked out in their new school gear. Eager to reunite with friends and favorite staff members, they are so ready to continue their learning journey!

Welcoming our new students and their families has also been a great pleasure. Albert Lacombe has grown by 78 new students this year (15 in preschool, 19 in kindergarten and 44 in Grades 1-6, with 11 new students in Gr 2, 4 and 5!). # **ARRIVAL AT SCHOOL**

We want to clarify our procedures for students arriving at school. Supervision is provided at the back of the school and students may play on the playground at 8:10 a.m. The first bell rings at 8:20 and students are to line up at their designated doors, where they will be met by their teachers.

As indicated in our previous message, we need all parking spots for staff. Parents, please do not park in the parking lot between 8:00 am and 3:15 pm.

SIGIS students may enter the building and head directly to their SIGIS room.

Sports Academy students may be scheduled at AL for their activities on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. They should proceed to the small gym to meet their instructors for 8:00 a.m.

If students are dropped off prior to 8:10 a.m., please know that we cannot provide supervision for these students. Our staff are still arriving and are getting ready for the day. Our office and admin staff have assigned duties and cannot be responsible for monitoring student behaviour. If families have an exceptional circumstances on a particular day, students can wait quietly in the front entrance and then go outside at 8:10 a.m. They are not to go to their lockers or coathooks until 8:20 a.m. as there is no supervision and their safety is important to us. Please make arrangements, including before/after school care, if needed, for your children so that they are safe and supervised at all times.

If parents are bringing their children to school, we ask that the students go to the back of the school at 8:10 a.m. and join their peers until the bell rings. If they are coming into the building, please keep them under your supervision until 8:20 a.m.

For Kindergarten students, building independence with their outdoor clothing and belongings is part of their learning. Please wait with them at the front entrance until 8:20 a.m. During severe weather, when wind chill and temperature are below -27C, students will be invited into the building and can wait in the hallway until 8:20 a.m.

# **DURING THE SCHOOL DAY**

We ask the assistance of all of our parents in helping us with maintaining the most productive learning environment. There are times when parents come to the classroom to drop off items or leave messages. Unfortunately, these drop-in visits can be a distraction to the students and interrupt the flow of lessons.

We are asking parents to come to the office with their items and we will facilitate their delivery. Also, if students are being picked up for appointments, please check in at the office to sign out your child and we will call them down for you.

# **DISMISSAL PROCEDURES**

For parents coming into the school to pick up their children at the end of the day, please wait at the front entrance until 2:58 p.m. when the dismissal bell rings, instead of waiting outside your child's classroom. If parents want to grab hockey bags from our Sports Academy storage room before the bell, that is fine. After the bell rings at 2:58, you are welcome to move to your child's classroom or locker/coathook area. In the interests of student safety, we can more closely monitor who is present in our school hallways during class times. Also, after school dismisal, supervision is only provided at the front of the school until the buses leave. Please recognize this if your children want to stop and play in the playground.

### **COMMUNICATING CONCERNS**

As our staff members spend quite a significant part of their day with your children, we want to hear from you if you have concerns about their life at school. Calling or E-mailing ahead to make an appointment is the best way to ensure that you will be able to have a private conversation with sufficient time and the teacher's full attention. This is a better alternative than trying to 'catch' our teachers in the morning when they are preparing for the day's lessons and greeting the children or after school when they may be supervising and assisting the children at dismissal times or have other meetings or appointments. We value our communication with you and the opportunity to receive and share an additional perspective on school events and happenings!

# **BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL CARE**

We are pleased to partner with SIGIS Child Care Society to offer high quality before/after school care for our students. SIGIS, a non-profit society, operating in St. Albert at a variety of locations for many years, has expanded to two rooms this year and can accommodate additional children, for morning and for after school care. They open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 6:00 p.m. For information, please call 780-499-9283

# TRAFFIC SAFETY UPDATE

We are pleased to see that many parents seem to have taken note of the information we provided earlier this week on Traffic Safety Tips around Albert Lacombe. were also joined by 3 members of our local RCMP on Thursday afternoon, helping us remind parents of the importance of teaching, modeling and regularly using our **Lighted Crosswalk** as the safest and only legal way of crossing Gainsborough Avenue. While it may take a few minutes more, helping our children learn to follow safety protocols is such a valuable life lesson! We would all feel terrible if a tragedy were to befall one of our students. Our School Patrols will be organized soon to provide additional support, but, in the meantime, please take advantage of the marked, lighted Crosswalk to help keep you and your children as safe as possible.

# **VOLUNTEER POLICY & CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK**

Our Volunteer Handbook and Registration Forms were sent home today. If you have Criminal Record Checks on file with us that are less than one year old you are still able to volunteer. We invite all parents to obtain your checks and register as a volunteer so that you are available to join your child's class for a wide variety of volunteer opportunities. Our school life is greatly enhanced by the support of volunteers. Some school events would be impossible to operate without your help! We thank you for taking the time to obtain these Checks as they help us to provide a high standard of care for your children.

### **LUNCH SUPERVISORS NEEDED**

We are in need of some additional people willing to work on a casual basis as lunch hour supervisors. Days of work are negotiable; we will accommodate your availability. The rate of pay for lunch hour supervisors is currently \$20.40 per day with an increase in October to \$22.40. The position of lunch hour supervisor is an important one as our supervisors work hard to help our children enjoy a safe and enjoyable lunch hour. Having a great break at lunchtime helps our students be at their best for their afternoon classes.
