There was a significant 'decline' in the overall parent results for our school...

- The overwhelming reason for the declines in our results
  - large number of parents responded with with 'unsure' or 'not applicable'
  - 25 out of the 67 requests for parent input have 0% parents who expressed a disagree or strongly disagree
  - The survey increased from 25 to 67 questions
  - Anyone could answer for the school
- Faculty responses were fairly consistent from last year to this year
- There were fluctuations in student responses
