The following supplies are required for the first day of classes, **Monday, August 29, 2023.** It is important that the specified items be purchased to provide uniformity in the kind of supplies each child will have.

- 1 1.5" Zippered Binder

- 2 Pens (blue)

- 1 Pair adult scissors

- 1 Math Protractor 4" (no geometry sets if possible)
